

Sixty-nine Prophecies Still to be Fulfilled

Before the Second Coming of the LORD

Part 3 – Prophecies 11 through 28 in Chronological Order

We ended Part 2 with the LORD breaking of the seventh seal and John's statement that there was "*silence in heaven for half an hour.*" I then asked the question, "What does that mean?" This is not the first time we have noticed "silence" from heaven. The last two sentences in the book of Malachi in the Old Testament announced the coming of Elijah. In the first words in Luke's story in the New Testament, Gabriel announced the birth of John the Baptist whom Jesus confirmed was the Elijah spoken of in Malachi. In between the two announcements, there was silence from heaven for four hundred years – about ten hours on heaven's time clock. During those years, much of the prophecy given in the Old Testament needed to transpire before the arrival of John the Baptist and Jesus. Heaven may have been silent, but God's Word was still working. The Persian Empire was in control in Malachi. The Grecian Empire had to come and transcend into the Roman Empire. The prophecies of Daniel 11:1-35 had to be fulfilled. We, in AD 2022, are waiting for Daniel 11:36 to occur next.

As for the silence in the seventh seal, the prophecies of the first six seals needed to catch up in time also. A half-hour in heaven's time is just over twenty years on earth's time. Seals one through four must continue to spin out in the world. None of them will come to an end. Their effects will continue on through the ages. The socialist agenda keeps raising its ugly head and becomes more invasive each time it does (Seal One). Think about the Spanish flue of the early 1900s. It was not eradicated. We still get flu shots to combat the lingering Spanish flu every year. We call it "influenza." People still die from that flu every year, but not in the numbers that they did when it first arrived. Yet, it still lingers in the world attacking every year. This current flu from Red China is more deadly and will not be eradicated. It, too, will be with us until the LORD returns (maybe Seal Two). But, be that as it may, specifically, the prophecies of Seal Six must have time to occur. Satan and his hordes who have just been cast out of heaven must reorganize on earth and energize the Satanic Empire of the Ten Toes. That will most likely take half an hour in heaven's time to occur, just over twenty years in earth's time. Twenty years represents birth to adulthood in the Old Testament. In Jewish life, a male had to be twenty years of age to be considered a warrior or a leader in the tribes. Those who are twenty when the seventh seal breaks will be rising in leadership over the next twenty years and will push the ten toes into the philosophy of the evil empire, as young adults historically push their agenda into the society they control. Silence will be in heaven for half an hour while that generation turns to support Satan like it has never done so before those days.

Satan's empire will consist of nine countries that touch and surround the Mediterranean Sea with the addition of the tenth being Britain. Satan will drive the formation of this empire when he arrives permanently on earth with his hordes. Seven of the ten countries will join Satan's choice for a leader willingly. He will make the seven his vice presidents or governors of the empire. Three leaders will not agree to enter their country into the alliance. Satan's choice leader will kill the three and not replace them. He will take their counties by force. Thus, Satan's kingdom, which fulfills the prophecy of Nebuchadnezzar's dream, will be a ten-country empire with seven leaders and one supreme leader. Daniel describes this empire as a seven-headed (leaders) beast with ten horns (countries). The choice leader will not come from Britain. He will come from one of the countries that touch the Mediterranean Sea. The Revelation tells us that he comes from the sea. It does mean that he is a sea creature; it means that his home country touched the sea. Satan will also install a prophet for this empire that will bring along his religion. He will not be from any of the nations in this empire; although, he will be the religious leader of these countries before all of this transpires. Revelation tells

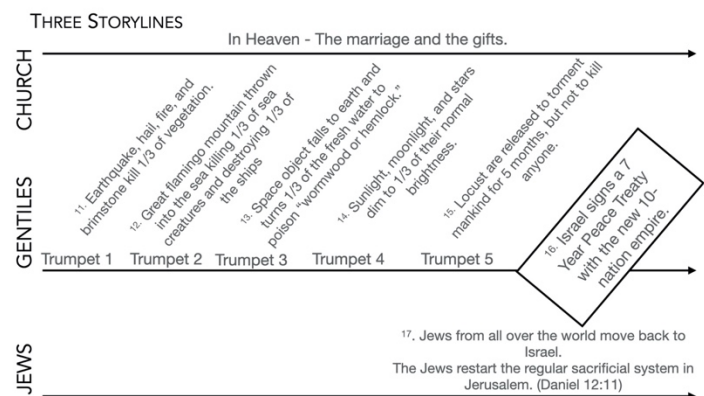
us that he will come from the land, not from the sea as did the choice leader. He comes from a land that does not touch the sea. He comes from the land where his religion is headquartered. When we look at the map of the ten nations and think about the prominent religion that controls them today, we can quickly notice that North Africa, Egypt, Syria, Turkey, Macedonia, parts of Greece, parts of Italy, most of Spain, most of France, and a small portion of Britain are Muslim. All of these countries have bowed to Sharia Law to some extent, some completely, some in regions with a heavy Muslim population as in Britain for example. The Revelation calls this man a false prophet and he will also control the old Babylonian area, which will include Iraq, Iran, Afghanistan, etc. This false prophet will be a Muslim cleric. We might rightly say that Satan already controls the Muslim religion as proven by their means of evangelism. As such, infidels must convert or be beheaded. Nothing in any of these prophecies happens on a whim, the actions that fulfill these prophecies must be birthed in the minds of the people, matured, and then come to fruition. It may also mean that it will take this choice leader twenty years in the public eye to be able to gain the trust of seven of the country's leaders to follow him. It all makes sense from that point why the Majesty in heaven requires silence for about a half hour. The LORD is waiting for all the needed parts to develop, connect, and fulfill the prophecy.

With the formation of Satan's empire, we have a beast of a nation comprised of ten countries, seven vice presidents, and Satan's choice leader. He will seem good at first but will turn out to be a beast, but he will not show his true colors until three and a half years into his treaty with Israel which has not been signed at this point in the story. He also has a false prophet. One beast is the empire itself, one beast is its leader, and the false prophet is its clergy.

With the formation of the empire, the Gentile storyline continues with prophecy 11. The seven seals were put in place by the LORD as He opened each in order to fulfill prophecy. It will take just over twenty years for all of Seal 6 to catch up. The last of Seal Six will be the snatching away of the Church in the rapture at the end of that twenty-year period. Seven trumpets will now sound in order to get the Gentile world where Satan wants it to be, but really it will be for the LORD to get Satan where He wants him to be. The LORD will have the angels in heaven blow each trumpet, but each trumpet sound will aggravate Satan and his empire to no end.

Prophecy 11 [Gentile Storyline] Trumpet 1 - Earthquake, hail, fire which kills 1/3 of trees and all of the vegetation (Rev. 8:5-7). The LORD sends a mighty storm upon the entire empire of Satan with thunder, lightning, and a great earthquake. Hail came with the storm. No doubt the fire will come from burning meteorites that ignite the dry trees and grass. But John was looking ahead in time and explaining it as he understood in his day. Today, when an earthquake erupts, it causes our electrical grid to tear apart and the electricity causes fires. If our insight is correct on the trumpet prophecies, as the LORD alludes to in Daniel 12:4 and 12:9-10, the destroyed earth, trees, and grass will only be on the landmass under the control of Satan in his new empire. All of the trumpets of the LORD in this section are to aggravate Satan and his empire.

Prophecy 12 [Gentile Storyline] Trumpet 2 - Great flaming mountain thrown into the sea killing 1/3 of sea creatures and destroying 1/3 of the ships (Rev. 8:8) All references to the "sea" in the Bible pertain to either the Mediterranean Sea, the Red Sea, the Sea of Suez, the Sea of Aqaba, the Sea of Galilee, or the Dead Sea. However, the largest sea under the control of Satan in his empire will be the



Mediterranean Sea. John does not know what this object is, but he says it looks like a big burning mountain that hit the sea to do damage. No doubt, this will be a large meteor. In February of 2013, a large meteor made it through the atmosphere and hit Russia killing over one thousand people in its destruction. It did all that damage as it landed in a small Russian lake. Had this meteor landed in the Mediterranean Sea instead of on land, the shock wave would have stunned marine life for miles and sent a giant wave that would have overtaken many sea-going vessels. The Revelation mountain will no doubt be much larger than the one that hit Russia.

Prophecy 13 [Gentile Storyline] Trumpet 3 – A space object falls to earth and turns 1/3 of the freshwater to poison “wormwood or hemlock” and men die. (Rev. 8:10-11) John calls this object a “great star” named “Wormwood.” Commentators of the past take this event to be symbolic of the times in which the people will be living. They say the word “wormwood” symbolizes troubles and calamity. I disagree. All of the rest of the prophecies are straightforward. Why would this one not be the same? Wormwood is not exactly poisonous. Perhaps John is using the word for a different herb of his day that was deadly. We do not know. What we do know from John is that when this star hits the freshwater sources, probably in the snowy mountain regions which feed most freshwater lakes and streams in Satan’s empire, the star will have some sort of deposits on it that will make the freshwater deadly. It will not affect all of the empire’s fresh water, just one-third of the water. With that being the case, logically, the tainted fresh water will probably be restricted to Satan’s land north of the Mediterranean Sea. If the star was to strike the upper Nile region and poison the river, the poisoned fresh water of the Nile would not make up one-third of the water in Satan’s empire.

Prophecy 14 [Gentile Storyline] Trumpet 4 – Sunlight, moonlight, and stars dim to 1/3 of their normal brightness (Rev. 8:12-13). An overcast of some kind will block the viewing of the sun, moon, and stars. [Note: The Second Coming, when it comes, will be on a cloudy day.]

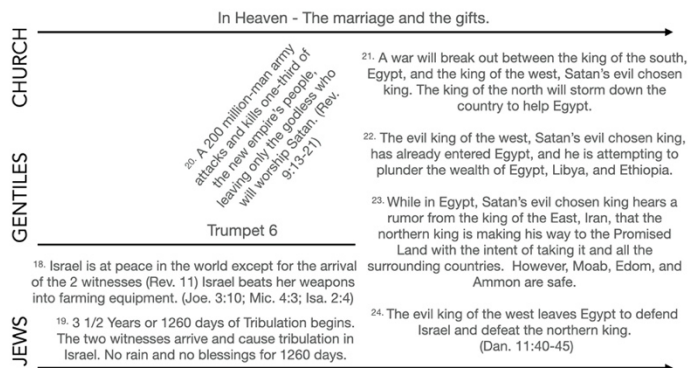
Prophecy 15 [Gentile Storyline] Trumpet 5 – Locust will be released to torment mankind for five months, but not to kill anyone. (Rev. 9:1-12). According to Revelation 9:1, this star, with the keys to open the bottomless pit to allow the release of these locusts, had already fallen from heaven. He did not fall at this time. He fell with Satan in Seal 6. But the release of evil locusts actually backfires on the demon with the key. The locusts will torment the people of Satan’s empire.

Prophecy 16 [Gentile Storyline] During the Time of Trumpet 5 – When things are so bad, Israel signs a 7 Year Peace Treaty with the Satanic ten-nation empire. (Dan. 9:27). To this point in the story, the evil empire and its leaders have not shown their evil intent.

Prophecy 17 [Gentile Storyline] During the Time of Trumpet 5 – Jews from all over the world begin to move back to Israel and begin the old regular sacrificial system in Jerusalem (Dan. 12:11).

Prophecy 18 [Jews Storyline]
Israel is at peace in the world except for the arrival of the two witnesses (Rev. 11) Israel beats her weapons into farming equipment. (Joe. 3:10; Mic. 4:3; Isa. 2:4)

Prophecy 19 [Jews Storyline]
Three and a half years or 1260 days of tribulation begins for Israel. The two witnesses arrive and cause the tribulation in Israel. No rain and no blessings for 1260 days. However, these two witnesses also protect Israel from the army from the east as well as all possible invaders for three and a half years.



Prophecy 20 [Gentile Storyline] Trumpet 6 – A two hundred-million-man army attacks and kills one-third of the new empire’s people, leaving only the godless who will worship Satan. (Rev. 9:13-21)

Prophecy 21 [Gentile Storyline] A war will break out between the king of the south, Egypt, and the king of the west, Satan’s evil chosen king. While these two are fighting, the king of the north will storm down the country to help Egypt. (Dan. 11:40-45)

Prophecy 22 [Gentile Storyline] The evil king of the west, Satan’s evil chosen king, has already entered Egypt, and he is attempting to plunder the wealth of Egypt, Libya, and Ethiopia. (Dan. 11:40-45)

Prophecy 23 [Gentile Storyline] While in Egypt, Satan’s evil chosen king hears a rumor from the king of the East (who with his 200 million army attacked the evil empire), that the northern king is making his way to the Promised Land with the intent of taking it and all the surrounding countries. (Dan. 11:40-45) This message from the king of the east is no doubt a trick to lure Satan’s chosen king into a trap because the king of the east, who has killed one-third of the people in Satan’s empire will join the kings of the south and north to fight Satan’s chosen king of the west.

Prophecy 24 [Gentile Storyline] The evil king of the west leaves Egypt to defend Israel and defeat the northern king. (Dan. 11:40-45)

However, Moab, Edom, and Ammon are safe because Satan’s chosen king stops the king of the north in the current area called Jordan before he reaches the land of Moab, Edom and Ammon. (Dan. 11:40-45)

NOTE: Israel cannot defend herself from the kings of the north, east, and south because she has invested in farming equipment instead of weapons. (Joel 3) She has to rely on the king of the west and his army. However, the two witnesses and her angel, Michael, are really her protection.

Prophecy 25 [Gentile Storyline] The kings of the north, east, and south join forces to attack Israel while she sits at peace. The name of the king of the north will be Gog. His name is the reason it is called the Battle of Gog. (Ezekiel 38-39)

Prophecy 26 [Gentile Storyline] The king of the west, (president of the 10-nation revived Satanic Empire with whom Israel made the Seven Year Peace Treaty), will come from his war efforts in Egypt to defend Israel on the east side of the Jordan River, in the current country of Jordan, not in Israel proper. (Ezekiel 38-39)

Prophecy 27 [Gentile Storyline] The king of the west defeats the kings of the north, south, and west. (Ezekiel 38-39)

Prophecy 28 [Gentile Storyline] The king of the west then moves his war camp to the west side of Jerusalem and pitches his tents between the Mediterranean Sea and the holy city. (Dan. 11: 45)

NOTE: At the end of the battle, three and a half years of the peace treaty with Israel have passed. Israel has been in tribulation because of their centuries of rebellion against the LORD. The LORD’s two witnesses have been the primary thorn in Israel’s side during these years. The king of the west intends to do away with them.

And so, we end this part of our series with two questions. Why will Satan’s chosen leader pitch his tents between the Mediterranean Sea and Jerusalem? Why will he not go ahead and enter the city of Jerusalem?
